Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment Support Team – Teacher on Special Assignment (TOSA) Duty Statement

Curriculum, Instruction, Assessment, and Equity Support TOSAs are standards and framework specialist who work collaboratively with site administrators, Curriculum Specialist, Blended Learning Specialist, Coordinated Integrated Services, and Librarians to build capacity for curriculum teams at each site. Their role is to facilitate and support teacher teams that will break down the standards, utilize the frameworks, align curriculum to the standards, aligned instructional guides, and identify the shifts in content. They will also support the integration of the ELD Framework to the content as well as integrate differentiation resources for ELs, SPED, FY, SWD students, and the integration of technology in all content areas. This will then support purpose lesson planning and instruction.

TOSAs will focus on coaching the site curriculum teams. TOSAs will build capacity with site curriculum teams in facilitating groups. They will help facilitate, train, and plan PD at school sites. They will also facilitate the work with the alignment and updating of EOCs and PTs in order for them to match the Instructional Guides. They will support sites in the use of data to drive instruction. They will coach site curriculum specialist to help teachers adjust instruction when it is not reaching each student.
