BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the Director of Educational Technology, design, maintain and update new and existing web sites and pages for the District; create and edit videos for various District-related projects.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

Create, maintain and update web pages and sites including the source coding; author web pages that contain information in the form of text and graphics; assure the quality of the home pages and the hypertext files contained therein; determine proper artistic and visual layout for web sites to potentially maximize exposure to the District.

Create and assure the functionality of the links, online forms, surveys and scripts running behind the web sites; scan, create and modify photographs and graphics for use on the web and reports; utilize external and internal web sites and shared folders to gather, manipulate and disseminate data and information to administrators, staff, students and others.

Troubleshoot problems of web pages and related applications and programs that run in conjunction with the web pages; run routine software tests, perform troubleshooting and provide routine maintenance of web pages.

Operate and utilize PC (with DOS and Windows) and/or Mac computers with various application software including Dreamweaver and other languages and utilities used in web design.

Create and edit videos for various District-related projects; utilize digital video equipment; operate the video broadcasting control room; travel to various sites to shoot videos as directed.

Prepare and maintain records related to assigned activities including a server index listing web files on the web server, password privileges for users and others as assigned; update and maintain database of video clips available for use.

Install, configure and troubleshoot computer hardware and software as needed.

OTHER DUTIES:

Make recommendations related to new software, tools and hardware related to web site development.

Perform related duties as assigned.
