This 3-unit program allows teachers to earn the ASDA Authorization quickly and conveniently by completing a two-day intensive weekend workshop. The workshop meets for full days beginning at 9 am and ending at 6 pm. Instruction is led by veteran and dynamic professionals with expertise in the field. Workshop content areas fulfill CCTC-guidelines and standards, and center on tools, resources and techniques for better serving ASD students in our special education classrooms and beyond.

Upon completion of the workshop, participants are required to complete an evidentiary that demonstrates professional experience and learning in the field. Portfolios are submitted online and detailed instructions and criteria for the assembly and contents of the portfolio are provided. Portfolios must be submitted and evaluated before the authorization may be issued.

- Minimum one year professional experience teaching students with autism
- Employment within a California K-12 school
- California teaching credential (preliminary or clear) in one of the following:
 - Mild/Moderate Disabilities
 - Deaf and Hard of Hearing
 - Physical and Health Impairments
 - Visual Impairments
