Special Qualifications/Description:

Teacher will report in-person to LVA-SOM (Teachers at LVA do not work from home). After training for virtual instruction is completed, teacher might be relocated to another SUHSD-LVA location. Teacher will also assume the role of supervising teacher (Academic Coach) of 25 students entering their attendance, providing support, and tracking satisfactory academic progress. It is strongly recommended that teacher is comfortable with the following online systems as they are required for instructional purposes: CANVAS, Microsoft TEAMS, Data Insights, Infinite Campus, Calendly, Microsoft Office Suite, and LOOM or similar. It is also recommended to have basic knowledge of computing hardware including cameras, microphones, Virtual Private Networks (VPN), dock station, and hotspots. Due to ongoing changes in student needs, teacher may need to provide instruction in 7-12 social science sections while at LVA.

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Duty Statement Item:

This position supports the implementation of a tiered system of support at school sites, providing the appropriate level of support to meet the diverse needs of all students. This system of support is designed to support students in academic, behavioral, and social-emotional and mental wellbeing domains.

Collaborate with the District MTSS team for professional learning in continuous improvement, implementation science, and whole child design.

Collaborate with school leadership team(s) to map tiered resources and supports for academics, behavior, and social-emotional and mental wellbeing.

Coordinate with site leaders to plan, implement, and monitor universal supports that set the conditions for learning to include Social Emotional Learning (SEL), Restorative Justice Practices (RJP), Positive Behavior Intervention Supports (PBIS), and Trauma Informed Practices (TIPs.)

Duties and Responsibilities:

TOSAs build capacity with School Curriculum Specialist and /or PLC lead to implement curriculum in each content area with fidelity.

- Work will focus on Curriculum. Specifically, IG's, and Assessment (PT's and informing EOCs.)
- Work directly with Site Curriculum Specialists and/or PLC Leads.
- Support and collaborate with the Site Curriculum Team (Adm., SCS, BLS, CIS, and Librarian) at each of the school sites.
- Work on ensuring that SCS are helping teachers implement curriculum with fidelity, and they are soliciting feedback along the way.
- Coach Site Curriculum Site Teams
- Coach PLC Leads
- Write and refine Instructional Guides
- Update resources on IGs
- Provide bi-weekly; quarterly and/or semester IG updates and focus areas of study within the IGs
- Collaborate with Site Curriculum Specialist SCS

 - Support PD at the sites by content
- Update all electronic resources, licenses, and provide sites on how to access them
- Provide State content specific updates to all teachers and provide PD
